

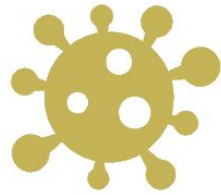

Learning Model Recommendations 1/4/2021

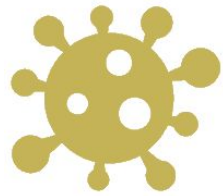


- **January 20th:** Grades K-5 will transition to a Hybrid Model (Gold/Green Day schedule) as a step to in-person learning. Pre-K will resume the previous Hybrid Model for the remainder of the school year.
- **January 26th:** Grades 6-12 will transition to a Hybrid Model (Gold/Green Day schedule). We will continue to monitor data and work with our Regional Support Team, Incident Command Team, Administration and School Board to determine if/when a move to full in-person learning could occur.
- **Week of February 8th:** Grades K-2 will transition to a full, In-Person Model.
- **Week of February 22nd:** Grades 3-5 will transition to a full, In-Person Model.

Notes:

- The 6-12 Learning model is still governed by the original guidelines and was not impacted by the Governor's December Executive Order. Full in-person learning for 6-12 is allowable if and when we have in-school and local numbers to support this less restrictive model.
- All Learning Models are impacted by current COVID data and ability to staff our programs.

Implementing the New MDE 12/24 Requirements

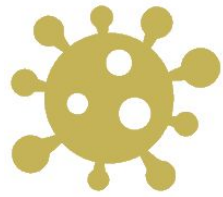


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1. COVID Saliva Testing for staff will be offered every other week at each site.
2. Face Masks and Shields
 - a. Masks continue to be mandatory for ALL students in grades K-12 and staff
 - b. A shield with a mask is not required, but is available for staff who wish to wear both
3. There will be no changes to Elementary Lunch and Specialist Locations
 - a. We are able to meet the requirements in our current plan
4. New Transportation Guidelines
 - a. Close contacts are defined as “two rows behind and ahead of the infected person for a period longer than 15 minutes.”
 - b. No eating or drinking allowed on the bus



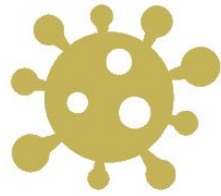
Vaccination Status



Status of COVID-19 Vaccinations in Chisago County: Jodi Budde and Colton Anderson, Chisago County Public Health



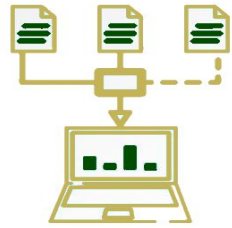
